Extension Services: Assist in the development and implementation of extension programs to educate farmers and rural communities. Support the organization of workshops, seminars, and training sessions on agricultural best practices. Aid in creating educational materials and resources for extension activities. Conduct field visits to engage with farmers and understand their needs and challenges. 4. Curriculum Development Support: Assist senior faculty in the review and enhancement of the agriculture extension curriculum.
