PROGRAMMES OFFERED

Postgraduate Diploma in Health & Leadership Management (HPGDHLM)

Successful completion of Bachelor's Degree in medicine, dentistry, nursing, health science or related discipline. Must be under the age of 45 and have a minimum of 5 Years professional experience in the expert field. Candidates from other sectors other than health may be considered on the merits of their prior qualifications and work experience and possession of sufficient experience to warrant posting to a leadership position within the public sector. **Endorsement by the MHMS is preferred.**

Bachelor of Nursing (Primary Health Care) (HBNPH)

Practicing registered nurse with a minimum of 2 years' experience post registration practice and holds a Diploma of Nursing Certificate OR Completion of Certificate in Nursing and has completed Pre-diploma and Pre-Degree Nursing - Bridging Programme with 2 years' work experience in the field of Primary Health Care.

Bachelor of Nursing (Child Health) (HBNCH)

Practicing registered nurse with a minimum of 2 years' experience post registration practice and holds a Diploma of Nursing Certificate OR Completion of Certificate in Nursing and has completed Pre-diploma and Pre-Degree Nursing - Bridging Programme with 2 years' work experience in the field of Child Health.

Bachelor of Nursing (Acute Care Nursing) (HBNA)

Practicing registered nurse with a minimum of 2 years' experience post registration practice and holds a Diploma of Nursing Certificate OR Completion of Certificate in Nursing and has completed Pre-diploma and Pre-Degree Nursing - Bridging Programme with 2 years' work experience in the field of Acute Care.

Diploma of Nursing (HDN)

Successful completion of Form 6 Arts or Science with a minimum Aggregate of 15 and less OR Completion of UPCIV/Preliminary studies with a GPA of 2.5 and above OR Completed Form 5 and worked as a registered Nurse-aid for minimum of 5 years with an award certificate of Pre-Diploma Nursing. **Pass HDN Standardize Entry Exam**

Diploma of Pharmacy Technology (HDPT)

Successful completion of Form 7 Science or UPCIV with minimum GPA of 2.8 and above; OR has been working in Pharmacy for more than 3 years with recommendations by Pharmacy Professionals.

Diploma of Community Based Rehabilitation (HDCBR)

Successful completion of Form 6 Arts/Science with a minimum aggregate of 18 and less OR Completion of UPCIV with minimum GPA of 2.5 and above OR has a minimum of 2 years' work experience in Social Work or Community development programmes.

Diploma of Nutrition and Dietetics (HDPND)

Successful completion of Form 6 Arts/Science with a minimum aggregate of 18 and less OR Completion of UPCIV with minimum GPA of 2.5 and above OR mature entry with work related experience of at least 5 years.

Diploma of Public Health (HDPH)

Successful completion of Form 6 Arts/Science with a minimum Aggregate of 15 and less OR Completion of UPCIV/ Preliminary studies with a GPA of 2.5 and above OR Completed Form 5 and has minimum work experience of 2 years. Attach formal recommendation from employer.

Pre-Diploma Nursing (HPHDN)

Completed Form 5 and worked as a registered nurse-aid for minimum of 3 years.

Pre-Degree Nursing (HPHBN)

Completed Diploma of Nursing and worked as a Registered Nurse.
